Councilwoman Grant made a motion to go into closed session. Councilwoman Sirocchi-Hurley seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed. Time 7:08 PM.

At the conclusion of the closed session, Councilwoman Grant made a motion to return to open session and reconvene in Council Chambers. Council President Putrino seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed. Time 9:45 PM.

#### **OPEN SESSION:**

Mayor Subrizi led the flag salute.

1. Grants Presentation - Capital Alternatives

The presentation was tabled to a future date.

2. Traffic Officer Recommendation – Rose Place

The Administrator reviewed the memo from Sgt. Pisano in which he recommended making Rose Place a one-way street during certain hours on school days. An ordinance will be prepared for introduction at the next meeting.

#### 3. NMEF - 5K/10K Date

Mayor Subrizi said the event is scheduled for October 27, 2018. She asked NMEF member, Jim Prendergast, if there is a rain date. Mr. Prendergast said there is not, the event will be held, rain or shine, on the 27<sup>th</sup>. There were no objections from the Council with regard to the date.

#### 4. Volunteer Party

Councilwoman Sirocchi-Hurley said the Volunteer Appreciation Party will be held on Monday, April 16<sup>th</sup> at the VFW. She said the VFW has donated the use of the hall and she and Councilwoman Langschultz will be working to secure donations of food and other items from the businesses in town. Mayor Subrizi said she will be out of town; she said she will prepare some comments and asked Council President Putrino to stand in for her.

Invitations will be going out through the Borough Clerk's office.

#### 5. Borough Pins

Council President Putrino referenced the pin design that was forwarded previously to the governing body. The design was approved and 500 pins will be ordered. Mayor Subrizi suggested distributing the pins to the volunteers at the volunteer party. Council President Putrino said they could also be given to honorees at future public events.

#### 6. Approval of the January 22, 2018 Closed, Work and Public Session Minutes

Councilman Grotsky made a motion to approve the minutes of January 22, 2018 Closed, Work and Public Session. Councilwoman Sirocchi-Hurley seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.

#### 7. Administrator's Report

The Administrator reported that the Kennedy Field Improvement Project will be advertised for bid on or about February 28<sup>th</sup> with a bid receipt date of March 14<sup>th</sup>. It is expected that the project will be awarded on or about March 26<sup>th</sup> with a project start date of June 15<sup>th</sup> and an anticipated completion date of September 15<sup>th</sup>.

The Administrator reported that the Berkley Field Improvement Project should be ready to go out to bid in mid-March with work scheduled to take place during school recess over the summer.

The Administrator said discussions have begun with the architect for the Borough Hall renovation. She said there had previously been some discussion of moving the Health Department up to the main floor of the Borough Hall. She said the members of the Health Department would like to remain in their current location, which they feel is well suited to their needs. She asked if there was any objection from the governing body. There was no

objection. She reviewed some of the preliminary decisions regarding the relocation of the Building Department, Municipal Court, Police Records, Senior Van, Social Services and OEM.

The Administrator referenced the memo received from the Health Officer, Sam Yanovich, regarding the pending legislation to allow cottage food sales. The governing body opted to hold off on any further discussion in lieu of any additional information that can be provided from the Health Department.

The Administrator referenced a request from Congressman Gottheimer to conduct mobile office hours in the Borough. The governing body enthusiastically endorsed the idea. The Administrator will coordinate with Congressman Gottheimer's office to schedule some time.

The Administrator referenced an email received from the Tax Assessor, in which he suggested the adoption of an ordinance to standardize the way we handle disabled veteran tax exemptions. She said she forwarded the information to the Borough Attorney for his review and the Assessor will attend the March work session to review his recommendation with the governing body.

#### **COUNCIL:**

Councilwoman Grant said she volunteered at the annual rabies clinic, which took place on February 10<sup>th</sup>. Councilwoman Grant said the Darren Drake Memorial has been tentatively scheduled for November 18<sup>th</sup>. Councilwoman Grant said she is working on the resolution to implement the proposal to create a municipal charity for the payment of property taxes.

Councilman Grotsky said the Parking Committee met for the first time and will be meeting on the third Tuesday of every month. Councilman Grotsky said he is reviewing the Shade Tree ordinance with the attorney and the Shade Tree Commission and they will be making a recommendation for revisions to the ordinance.

Council President Putrino said the recycling center has been rearranged to facilitate a better flow into and out of the recycling center. He said as of today, gabled cartons are now recyclable. Council President Putrino said there are two shredding events scheduled this year, the first on May 5<sup>th</sup> and the second in November. He said a new app is being launched called Recycling Coach. He said the first year is being paid for by the State and the BCUA may pick up the cost in future years. He said if it is not covered by the BCUA it will cost the municipality approximately \$1,000 annually. Council President Putrino said the Finance Committee will be meeting on February 14<sup>th</sup> and the Budget Committee will be meeting on February 21<sup>st</sup>. Councilman Putrino said the Suez Field Committee has continued to meet, most recently on February 8<sup>th</sup> with members of the Board of Education. The committee would like work with Boswell to begin drafting the design. He asked to have a resolution on the next meeting agenda to authorize Boswell to begin the design work.

Mayor Subrizi said she, along with the Bergen County Mayors, met with Governor Phil Murphy of February 5<sup>th</sup>. She said the topics included infrastructure, transportation, sustainability,

opportunity zones, the arbitration cap and affordable housing. She said she also received a call from Governor Murphy to congratulate New Milford on being named the second safest city in New Jersey. Mayor Subrizi said she has received a proposal from an Eagle Scout candidate that she will be forwarding to the Council for their review in advance of a discussion at the next meeting.

#### APPOINTMENTS: PETER HUGERICH – FIRE CO. #2

Councilwoman Grant made a motion to approve the appointment of Peter Hugerich to Fire Co. #2. Councilwoman Sirocchi-Hurley seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.

#### ARMINEH DE BOER – BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE

Council President Putrino made a motion to approve the appointment of Amineh DeBoer to the Beautification Committee. Councilwoman Grant seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.

#### JANET GROTSKY - BOARD OF HEALTH

Councilwoman Grant made a motion to approve the appointment of Janet Grotsky to the Board of Health. Councilwoman Sirocchi-Hurley seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, except Councilman Grotsky who abstained.

#### FRANCES BRUNNER - BOARD OF HEALTH

Council President Putrino made a motion to approve the appointment of Frances Brunner to the Board of Health. Councilwoman Grant seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.

#### COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Councilwoman Grant made a motion to open to the public. Councilwoman Sirocchi-Hurley seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.

Mr. Kelly stated that public comment is intended for the good and welfare of the Borough.

Edward Kilarjian – 3030 Edwin Avenue, Fort Lee. Prior to Mr. Kilarjian's comments, Mayor Subrizi excused herself from the dais. Council President Putrino came forward to preside over the meeting in the Mayor's absence. Mr. Kilarjian commented on the time he recently spent in jail. He further noted the existence of a pothole at the intersection of Bergen Avenue and River Road.

Being no other members of the public who wished to comment, Councilwoman Grant made a motion to close to the public. Councilwoman Sirocchi-Hurley seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.
