2. Administrator's Report

• The Covid-19 Task Force met on November 5th. There were reports from the NMPD, NMFD, OEM, Health Department, Administration, DPW, Recreation and the Board of Education. Some of the topics discussed included the extension of outdoor dining permits, heaters and tent safety; event participation waivers; winter sports; the holiday Giving Tree and the Fire Department toy drive, and upcoming events including Veteran's Day, the ADAM Event and the Holiday Tree Lighting

- The Clerk is working with the attorney to draft a resolution to extend the borough's outdoor dining permits, consistent with the extension from the State through 3/31/21
- The 4th quarter finance meeting is scheduled for 11/19
- The Certified Floodplain Manager has drafted the update to the Borough's Stormwater Control ordinance, based upon the NJ DEP's Stormwater Best Management Practices Manual. The ordinance will be on the next agenda for introduction
- The Administrator will be a meeting on 11/17 with the Mayor, the BOH liaison, the BOH President and the Public Health Nurse to begin the discussion on the best plan to move forward with the Public Health Nurse position after the current nurse retires next spring

INTRODUCE ORDINANCE 2020:16

BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE UNDERTAKING OF THE KNIGHTS FIELD DEVELOPMENT PROJECT IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$960,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.
