Councilwoman Greco-Langschultz made a motion to go into closed session. Councilwoman Grant seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed. Time 7:07 PM.

At the conclusion of the closed session, Councilwoman Grant made a motion to return to open session. Councilwoman Sirocchi-Hurley seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed. Time 7:26 PM.

OPEN SESSION:

Mayor Putrino asked for a motion to add the topic of the Kennedy Field plaque to the agenda. Councilwoman Grant made a motion to add it to the agenda. Councilwoman Greco-Langschultz seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.

Mayor Putrino said he was appointing Councilman Seymour as the liaison to the Knights Field Committee.

1. Solid Waste Bid Results

The Administrator reported on the bid results. She explained that there were two bid openings; one for a joint contract with River Edge and one for an individual contract. She said the reason it was bid both ways is because River Edge wanted to bid individually in order to get pricing for twice per week pick-up for the entire year. She said the results for both the joint bid and the solo bid were favorable and either would be acceptable. She said she is

waiting to hear back from River Edge on whether or not they would like to proceed with the joint contract award.

2. Approval of the minutes from the January 28, 2019 Closed, Work and Public Sessions

Councilwoman Greco-Langschultz made a motion to approve the minutes from the January 28, 2019 Closed, Work and Public Sessions. Councilwoman Grant seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.

3. Administrator's Report

The Administrator reported that the pre-construction meeting for the Faller Drive Resurfacing project was held that day. She said, weather permitting, the work is scheduled for mid-April to coincide with the school spring break.

The Administrator said the contract for electricity procurement was signed with Engie Resources on Friday, February 8th, locking in a price of .11599 per kilowatt for all of the electric meters in the borough. The contract begins April 1st and runs for two years.

The Administrator said the Recreation office is being relocated to the Borough Hall into the former police department locker room.

The Administrator advised that the Borough will be closed on Monday, February 18^{th} for President's Day.

4. Kennedy Field Plaque

Mayor Putrino said he had hoped there would be a joint opening day for Little League and softball at which Kennedy Field could be rededicated; since that is not the case he suggested Memorial Day. He distributed a rendering of the proposed plaque. All present approved the wording and design as proposed. Mayor Putrino said the plaque would be placed next to the original dedication plaque on the Recreation building. The ceremony will take place after the parade at approximately 11:30 AM. The Administrator will notify the Recreation Director and ask him to contact all of the organizations that use the field.

Councilman Grotsky announced that Chief Ramaci will be "walked out" from the department on February 12th at 4:00 PM. Councilman Grotsky asked Mr. Kelly for the status of the vacant property ordinance. Mr. Kelly said he is working on the draft.

Councilwoman Greco-Langschultz said the members of the Recreation Advisory Committee are asking for clarification of their role and that some members may attend a future Council meeting.

Mayor Putrino asked to have Art Castronova moved from an Alternate Member to a Full Member on the Rent Leveling Board. The appointment will be listed on the next agenda.

Council President Duffie asked about the address of the Police Department noting it is listed as 930 River Road, which caused confusion during a delivery. The Administrator will review and report back to the governing body.

Councilwoman Grant said she had made an inquiry a few months ago to request a sign on the west side of the Boulevard near Fulton. She asked for the status. The Administrator will review and report back.

Councilman Grotsky commented on the entrance/exit to the Brookchester Shopping Center, noting that a number of people enter through the exit and exit through the entrance. He asked to have the property owner notified of the issue and to ask them to take some action to remedy the situation.

Mayor Putrino said he will be out of state on February 13th and 14th; Council President Duffie will be in charge during his absence.
