**WORK SESSION:**

Mayor Putrino read the Open Public Meeting and Mission Statements.

Councilwoman Grant made a motion to go into closed session. Councilman Seymour seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed. Time 7:02 PM.

**CLOSED SESSION:**

1. Contract Negotiation – New Milford Swim Club Lease
2. Legal Advice – Hirschfeld Brook
3. Review of Closed Session Minutes

At the conclusion of the closed session, Councilwoman Greco-Langschultz made a motion to return to open session. Councilwoman Grant seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed. Time 7:32 PM.

**OPEN SESSION:**

1. DPW Staffing

The Administrator reported that the permanent part-time DPW employee has given notice and his last day will be July 26<sup>th</sup>. She said there are two other employees that are out on workmen's compensation and the DPW is short staffed. She said the Director has asked permission to advertise for a full-time employee with a September start date. She said the cost would be covered as the Director included the addition of two new employees in his budget, with none hired to date. In addition, there have been salary savings for the two employees out on workmen's compensation.

Councilman Grotsky made a motion to authorize the advertisement for a full-time DPW employee. Councilwoman Greco-Langschultz seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.

## 2. Police Department – Purchase/Lease Vehicle

The Administrator said the Police Department has traditionally leased their vehicles through the use of a state contract. She said the Borough has recently learned that the state contract is only valid for purchase and cannot be used for leased vehicles. She said going forward we will need to go out to bid either independently or through a cooperative in order to lease vehicles. She said the Police Department has asked to purchase one SUV this year for \$37,837 and funds are available in the capital improvement fund. She said there is currently \$269,000 in the capital improvement fund and we are returning an additional \$44,000 back to capital improvement via resolution 2019:163.

Council President Duffie made a motion to approve the request to purchase the SUV with funds from the capital improvement fund. Councilwoman Sirocchi-Hurley seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.

## 3. Proposed Marijuana Ordinance

Mr. Kelly said the issue discussed last year was with regard to legalization. He said this was tabled and is currently in limbo, however there has been a recent amendment which loosens the regulations on dispensaries. He said this change will likely bring an increase in the number of applicants for dispensaries. Mr. Kelly said the statute is broad and he recommends adopting an ordinance, prohibiting dispensaries in the Borough, in order to maintain local control. He said it is possible that the Borough would need to take further action if the state were to move forward with legalization, which would invalidate anything previously adopted.

Mr. Kelly said the ordinance is on the agenda for introduction and subsequent to introduction it will need to be referred to the local Planning Board and the County Planning Board for their review.

## 4. Administrator's Report

The Administrator asked to add resolution 2019:174 to the agenda for the disposition of surplus property to authorize the online auction of bicycles that have been abandoned or recovered in the borough. There was no objection and the resolution was added to the consent agenda.

The Administrator reported that the New Milford Swim Club asked to borrow the Borough's portable lights for an event scheduled on August 2<sup>nd</sup>. It will be coordinated through the DPW.

The Administrator said the Police Department has reported that there are no traffic issues that would merit any changes in the vicinity of Shop Rite. The situation will be reevaluated when school reopens.

The Administrator reported the Municipal Drug Alliance is struggling. She said a longtime member who has served as both the chair and treasurer has recently stepped down and they have had difficulty getting their paperwork filed in a timely manner with the County. She said she was recently advised that it would be permissible to use a small amount of the grant to pay a stipend to someone to do the work. She is coordinating with the chairperson to determine

whether or not there is someone on the committee or within the borough that would be willing to take on the responsibility of the reporting.

The Administrator said the preconstruction meeting for the Borough Hall renovation is tentatively scheduled for July 31<sup>st</sup>.

The Administrator reported that the bid opening for the 2019 road program, which includes Bulger Avenue and the addition of two handicapped ramps on River Road, is scheduled for August 8<sup>th</sup>.

The Administrator reported that seventy-nine percent of municipal users have completed the mandatory cybersecurity training. She said those that have yet to complete the training are primarily from the borough's two land use boards and she has asked the secretaries from each of the boards to remind members of this requirement.

The Administrator reported that she will be out of the office from August 9<sup>th</sup> through the 19<sup>th</sup> and reminded everyone of the next meeting on August 26<sup>th</sup>.

## **COUNCIL:**

Councilwoman Greco-Langschultz asked for the status of the Fire Department's boot drive. She was advised that it has been relisted for discussion at the August 26<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Councilman Seymour commented on the car show recently held in town, noting it was well attended.

Councilman Grotzky reminded everyone of National Night Out, scheduled for August 6<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 – 10:00 PM. He also commented on the recent Finance Committee meeting, noting that both expenditures and revenue are on track.

Councilwoman Sirocchi-Hurley said the chairperson of the Stigma Free Committee recently gave birth. She also commented on the success of the Elks Carnival.

Council President Duffie referenced ordinance 2019:18 on the agenda, noting it is intended to address the need for inspections, prior to construction, in order to mitigate the rat problem associated with any land disturbance. Council President Duffie also referenced the proposed ordinance for single use bags, noting the Environmental Commission has worked very hard to develop this draft. She also reported the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Committee will be holding its first meeting on July 29<sup>th</sup>.

Councilwoman Grant said the last section of the Library roof has been replaced but there is a leak that will be addressed by the contractor. Councilwoman Grant said New Milford Village came before the Planning Board with an application for a community center with an additional 64-67 parking spaces. She said the application was approved by the Board. Councilwoman Grant commented on a Bergen County Senior Art Show which recently opened at the Art Center of New Jersey; winners from each category will advance to the State competition in September.

Mayor Putrino commented on the public safety leadership team meeting held the previous week. He said a number of items were discussed including issues with dispatch and the military surplus program. He said the meeting was productive and he plans to hold them on a quarterly basis.

Councilwoman Grant made a motion to reconvene in Council chambers. Council President Duffie seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.

## **PUBLIC SESSION:**

Mayor Putrino called the meeting to order, asked for a moment of silent prayer and/or reflection and led the flag salute. Mayor Putrino read the Open Public Meeting Law and Mission Statements and pointed out the fire exits in the Conference Room.

## **5. Field Committee Recommendation**

Phil Tenant – 319 Lacey Drive. Mr. Tenant identified himself as the chairperson of the Knights Field Committee. Mr. Tenant referenced the written recommendation, which had been forwarded earlier in the day and then reviewed the four options outlined in the recommendation. He said the first option is for an indoor recreation/community center, which the committee overwhelmingly supports as the best possible use of the property. This option also includes an outdoor park/picnic area. Mr. Tenant outlined Option 2 as a multi-use lighted field with synthetic turf; Option 3 as a Central Park Theme with a great lawn, picnic areas, playground and an outdoor atrium; and Option 4 where half the property would be used as a synthetic turf lighted field and the other half would be for a park, picnic area and playground.

Mr. Tenant said the committee also agrees that there is no need to develop the property at this time, suggesting that the Borough could wait until such time as additional money can be budgeted or obtained through grants.

Mayor Putrino asked why more than one of the options presented included synthetic turf. Mr. Tenant said because it is easier to maintain and there is almost no downtime on a synthetic turf field.

Councilwoman Greco-Langschultz asked if it has been confirmed that building a structure on the property would be permitted. Mr. Kelly said it has not been confirmed.

Councilman Seymour thanked the committee for their work.

## 6. Single Use Bags – Proposed Ordinance

Council President Duffie referenced the draft ordinance provided by the Environmental Commission. She said the commission has spent a great deal of time researching the ordinance and has modeled it after the recently enacted Glen Rock ordinance.

Councilwoman Grant said she applauds the commission's efforts but said she believes there are some things that require clarification.

Jeffrey Del Vecchio, Lisa Sandhusen and Lauren Maeherlein from the Environmental Commission, came forward to address the Council and respond to questions.

Councilwoman Grant asked for clarification as to what bags would be included. Mr. Del Vecchio said a simple distinction would be that any plastic bag with handles would be prohibited; plastic bags without handles would be excluded.

Councilwoman Grant asked about the temporary exemptions and suggested the need for criteria for the governing body to use in determining whether or not a hardship exists.

Ms. Sandhusen said education would be part of the one-year implementation period, suggesting the use of flyers, a press release and dissemination of information through the Borough website. Mr. Del Vecchio said the commission plans to begin the education process at National Night Out.

Councilwoman Greco-Langschultz asked how the ordinance would be enforced.

After additional discussion, Mr. Kelly summarized the Council's comments and asked the commission to reconsider and clarify the following: the definition of enforcement; what would constitute the criteria for an exemption; a comparison to any ordinance that is already in effect; a plan for enforcement; and an educational plan outlining how it will be implemented.

## **COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

Councilwoman Greco-Langschultz made a motion to file Committee Reports with the Borough Clerk to be spread in full upon the minutes. Councilman Grotsky seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.

## **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

Councilwoman Grant made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 24, 2019 Closed, Work and Public Session meetings. Council President Duffie seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor except Councilwoman Greco-Langschultz and Councilman Grotsky who abstained.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

### **INTRODUCE ORDINANCE 2019:18**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD, THEREBY ADDING CHAPTER BH:XV ENTITLED "INSPECTION PRIOR TO BUILDING, DEVELOPMENT OR CLEARING"

Councilwoman Greco-Langschultz made a motion to introduce this ordinance on the first reading. Councilwoman Grant seconded the motion. The motion carried on a roll call vote. All present in favor, none opposed.

The ordinance will be advertised and a public hearing will be held on August 26, 2019.

### **INTRODUCE ORDINANCE 2019:19**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER XXX OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD THEREBY AMENDING SUBSECTION 30-20 ENTITLED "GENERAL PROVISIONS"

Councilwoman Greco-Langschultz made a motion to introduce this ordinance on the first reading. Councilwoman Sirocchi-Hurley seconded the motion. The motion carried on a roll call vote. All present in favor, none opposed.

When casting her vote, Councilwoman Grant said she struggled with the decision, knowing that so many benefit from medical marijuana but said she is not sure that New Milford is the appropriate place for it to be sold.

The ordinance will be advertised and referred to the New Milford Planning Board and forwarded to the Bergen County Planning Board. A public hearing will be held on September 23, 2019.

Mayor Putrino noted the addition of resolution 2019:174 to authorize the disposition of additional surplus property not included in resolution 2019:169.

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with applicable Council on Affordable Housing ("COAH") regulations and the New Jersey Uniform Housing Affordability Controls ("UHAC") N.J.A.C. 5:80-26., et seq., the Borough of New Milford is required to adopt by resolution an Affirmative Marketing Plan to ensure that all affordable housing units created, including those created by rehabilitation are affirmatively marketed to very low, low and moderate income households, particularly those living and/or working within Housing Region 1, the Housing Region encompassing the Borough of New Milford;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, do hereby adopt the following Affirmative Marketing Plan:

**Affirmative Marketing Plan**

- A. All affordable housing units in the Borough of New Milford shall be marketed in accordance with the provisions herein unless otherwise provided in N.J.A.C. 5:93-1, et seq. This Affirmative Marketing Plan shall apply to all developments that contain or will contain very low, low or moderate-income units, including those that are part of the Borough's prior round obligation and its current Fair Share Plan, and those that may be constructed in future developments not yet anticipated by the Fair Share Plan.
- B. The Affirmative Marketing Plan shall be implemented by an Administrative Agent designated by and/or under contract with the Borough of New Milford. All the costs of advertising and affirmatively marketing affordable housing units shall be borne by the developers/sellers/owners of the affordable unit(s).

C. In implementing the Affirmative Marketing Plan, the Administrative Agent, acting on behalf of the Borough, shall undertake all the following strategies:

1. Review, approve and ensure that the developers/sellers/owners publish at least one advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation within the housing region.
2. Broadcast of one advertisement by a radio or television station broadcasting throughout the housing region.
3. At least one additional regional marketing strategy using one of the other sources listed below at Sec. E of this plan.

D. The Affirmative Marketing Plan is a regional marketing strategy designed to attract buyers and/or renters of all majority and minority groups, regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital or familial status, gender, affectional or sexual orientation, disability, age or number of children to housing units which are being marketed by a developer or sponsor of affordable housing. The Affirmative Marketing Plan is also intended to target those potentially eligible persons who are least likely to apply for affordable units in that region. It is a continuing program that directs all marketing activities toward Housing Region 1 in which the Borough is located and covers the entire period of deed restriction for each restricted housing unit.

E. The Affirmative Marketing Plan is a continuing program intended to be followed throughout the entire period of restrictions and shall meet the following requirements:

1. All newspaper articles, announcements and requests for applications for very low, low, and moderate-income units shall appear in the Star Ledger.

The primary marketing shall take the form of at least one press release and a paid display advertisement in the above newspaper during the first week of the marketing program. Additional advertising and publicity shall be on an "as needed" basis. The developer/owner shall disseminate all public service announcements and pay for display advertisements. The developer/owner shall provide proof of publication to the Administrative Agent. All press releases and advertisements must be approved in advance by the Borough's Administrative Agent.

7. A random selection method to select occupants of very low, low and moderate-income housing will be used by the Borough's Administrative Agent in conformance with N.J.A.C. 5:80-26.16(l).
8. The Affirmative Marketing Plan shall provide a regional preference for all households that live and/or work in Housing Region 1 comprised of Hudson, Passaic, and Sussex, and Bergen Counties.
9. The Borough of New Milford may enter into an agreement with a developer or residential development owner to provide a preference for affordable housing to low to moderate income veterans who served in time of war or other emergency, as defined in section 1 of P.L. 1963, c.171 (C.54:4-8.10), of up to 50 percent of the affordable units in that particular project. This preference shall be established in the applicant selection process for available affordable units so that applicants who are veterans who served in times of war or other emergency, and who apply within 90 days of the initial marketing period shall receive preference for the rental of the agreed-upon percentage of affordable units.
10. The Administrative Agent shall administer the Affirmative Marketing Plan. The Administrative Agent has the responsibility to income qualify very low, low and moderate income households; to place income eligible households in very low, low and moderate income units upon initial occupancy;; to continue to qualify households for reoccupancy of units as they become vacant during the period of affordability controls; to assist with outreach to very low, low and moderate income households; and to enforce the terms of the deed restriction and mortgage loan as per N.J.A.C. 5:80-26.1, et seq.
11. Whenever appropriate, the Administrative Agent shall provide or direct qualified very low, low and moderate-income applicants to counseling services on subjects such as budgeting, credit issues, mortgage qualifications, rental lease requirements and landlord/tenant law and shall develop, maintain and update a list of entities and lenders willing and able to perform such services.

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12. All developers/owners of very low, low and moderate-income housing units shall be required to undertake and pay the costs of the marketing of the affordable units in their respective developments, subject to the direction and supervision of the Administrative Agent. The implementation of the Affirmative Marketing Plan for a development that includes affordable housing shall commence at least 120 days before the issuance of either a temporary or permanent certificate of occupancy.
13. The implementation of the Affirmative Marketing Plan shall continue until all very low, low and moderate-income housing units are initially occupied and for as long as affordable units exist that remain deed restricted and for which the occupancy or reoccupancy of units continues to be necessary. Please note that in addition to complying with this Borough-wide Affirmative Marketing Plan that the Administrative Agent shall also review and approve a separate Affirmative Marketing Plan for every new affordable development in New Milford that is subject to N.J.A.C. 5:80-26.1 et seq. That document shall be completed by the owner/developer and will be compliant with the Borough's Affirmative Marketing Plan as presented herein, and incorporate development specific details and permitted options, all subject to the Administrative Agent's review and approval. The development specific affirmative marketing plans will use the standard form for Region 1, which is attached hereto as Appendix III.
14. The Administrative Agent shall provide the Municipal Housing Liaison with the information required to comply with monitoring and reporting requirements pursuant to N.J.A.C.5:80-26-1, et seq. and the Order granting the Borough a Final Judgment of Compliance and Repose.
