

ORDINANCE NO. 2019:21

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER VII OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD ENTITLED "TRAFFIC," THEREBY AMENDING SUBSECTION 7-6 ENTITLED "THROUGH STREETS, STOP INTERSECTIONS AND YIELD INTERSECTIONS" AND SUBSECTION 7-13 ENTITLED "SPEED LIMITS."

WHEREAS, the members of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford have been advised that the present ordinance does not adequately address the traffic safety concerns that presently affect the residents of New Milford; and

WHEREAS, the matter has been reviewed by the Traffic Officer, Sgt. Justin Pisano, and a recommendation has been made to the Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford wish to amend Chapter VII entitled "Traffic" to address the safety concerns that affect the needs of residents;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford that Chapter VII, Section 7-6.2, Stop Intersections, is hereby amended to add the following:

Robert Chester Way at Patrolman Ray Woods Lane
STOP sign to be installed on the Southeast corner of Patrolman Ray Woods Lane.

Patrolman Ray Woods Lane
STOP sign to be installed on Patrolman Ray Woods Lane approximately 414 feet west of River Road on the northern curb line.

Columbia Street
STOP sign to be installed on Columbia Street on the northwest corner at the intersection of Patrolman Ray Woods Lane.

BE IT FURTHER ORADAINED that section 7-6.3, Yield Intersections, is hereby amended to add the following:

On Patrolman Ray Woods Lane at the northeast corner of Robert Chester Way.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that section 7-13, Speed Limits, be amended to add the following:

<i>Name of Street</i>	<i>Side</i>	<i>Speed Limit</i>	<i>Location</i>
Robert Chester Way	Both	10 MPH	from Trotta Drive to Patrolman Ray Woods Lane

Columbia Street	Both	10 MPH	from Patrolman Ray Woods Lane to Hardcastle Pond
Patrolman Ray Woods Lane	Both	10 MPH	from River Road to Robert Chester Way

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of this ordinance remains unchanged and that this amendment shall become effective upon passage and publication in accordance with law.
